

NJBiz – “Best 50 Women in Business”

Selection Criteria:

- Must be a female resident or be employed in New Jersey.
- May be self-nominated or nominated by another person.
- Nominees must hold a senior management-level position with significant authority in decision making.
- Cannot be a past award recipient, member of the judge’s panel or a member of the judges’ immediate family.

The judges will concentrate on five areas with particular emphasis on leadership and vision.

Please provide a narrative highlighting the five areas below.

1. Career Accomplishments

Include organizations where the nominee works, and has worked, with important dates, titles and responsibilities. (Additional information could include: significant professional accomplishments; licenses, degrees, areas of professional expertise; honors and awards (list dates, etc.); special skills and abilities)

2. Leadership

Include organization successes and obstacles the nominee has overcome, professional creativity and innovation.

3. Vision

Include entrepreneurial activities and initiatives and/or business growth.

4. Community Service

Include past and present active involvement in community organizations where the nominee has made a significant impact.

5. Mentoring

Include examples of how the nominee supports the personal and/or professional growth of other women.
