Forty under 40 looks for candidates who share a commitment to business growth, to professional excellence and to the community—people who are shaping the economic future of New Jersey.

Nomination Entry Fee: \$99.00

The 2018 honorees will be recognized in the following categories:

- Accounting
- Banking
- Entrepreneur
- Healthcare
- Law
- Marketing
- Real Estate Development
- Technology

Eligibility:

- Must be 39 years old or younger on September 20, 2018.
- Must be currently employed in New Jersey.
- May be self-nominated or nominated by another person.
- Cannot be a member of the judging panel, or a member of any judge's immediate family.
- Must be an owner, partner, president, CEO, CFO, COO, board chair, or other senior-level executive or manager in one of the following industries: Accounting, Banking, Entrepreneur, Healthcare, Law, Marketing, Real Estate Development and Technology.
- Only one individual may be nominated per company.
- Must not be a previous Forty Under 40 award recipient.

The candidate’s biographical profile should describe his/her professional accomplishments, leadership qualities, vision and community involvement in no more 1200 words. Use the headings below, in the order that they appear, to label the narrative. The bulleted items are examples of what could be included in the narrative.

A. Professional Accomplishments

Include organizations where the nominee currently works and has previously worked. Detail important dates, titles and responsibilities.

Additional information could include:

- Significant professional accomplishments
- Licenses, degrees, areas of professional expertise
- Honors and awards (list dates, etc.)
- Special skills and abilities

B. Leadership

Include organizational successes and obstacles the nominee has overcome, professional creativity and innovation.

C. Vision

Include entrepreneurial activities and initiatives and/or business growth.

D. Community Service

Include past and present active involvement in community organizations where the nominee has made a significant impact.

Additional information could include:

- Nature of involvement
- Honors and awards
- Milestones and/or significant accomplishments on behalf of community organizations
