Do not have line breaks per paragraph. Make sure all fields are complete before hitting submit.

Eligibility:

- Must be 39 years of age or younger before the May 10, 2018 event date
- Individuals also must be headquartered in the greater Philadelphia area. This includes:
 - PA - City of Philadelphia, Bucks County, Delaware County, Montgomery County, Berks County, Chester County, Lancaster County and Lehigh County.
 - NJ - Camden County, Burlington County, Gloucester County, Atlantic County, Salem County, Cumberland County, and Cape May County
 - DE - Kent County, and New Castle County
- May be self-nominated or nominated by another person.
- Must not be a previous 40 Under 40 award recipient.
- Must be available to attend the awards program on Thursday, May 10, 5:00pm - 8:00pm.

The best candidates will quantitatively demonstrate business success (financial results, career growth), community involvement (volunteer work, advocacy), leadership ability (public profile, reputation) and influence (impact on the region, on public policy, or on quality of life).

Awards:
