Eligibility

Eligible lawyers must call one of the following counties their primary place of business: Philadelphia, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, Lancaster, Berks, Lehigh counties in Pennsylvania; Camden, Gloucester, Burlington, Salem, Cumberland, Atlantic, Cape May in New Jersey; and New Castle and Kent in Delaware

*Nominees must be available to attend the awards program on the evening of October 25th, 2018 to be considered.
