From 2008 to 2011, Adam was an adjunct professor at Drexel University's Law School, where he taught lawyering skills and environmental law concepts to second- and third-year law students in a clinical practice setting.

During law school, Adam served as executive editor of the *University of Pennsylvania Law Review* and received the Edwin Keedy Award for Outstanding Contribution to the *Law Review*.
