Jason recommended the disposition of these matters and drafted decisions for the OCB's adjudicative boards.

Jason is a graduate of Cornell University, School of Industrial and Labor Relations, and Brooklyn Law School, where he was a recipient of a Prince Merit Scholarship and served as articles editor of the *Brooklyn Journal of Corporate, Financial and Commercial Law*.
