Mass Tort and Product Liability

Michael has done extensive work representing major companies against national mass tort and product liability claims, including toxic torts. In the past several years alone, Michael and his team have overseen the resolution of thousands of mass product liability claims arising in federal and state jurisdictions throughout the United States. At any given time, the team is managing over 15,000 cases nationwide. He also assists clients with less than 10 claims in their inventory that may not have the volume, but experience the same litigation risks. These include cases being presented in some of the country's most challenging venues (e.g. New York, California, Illinois and Pennsylvania).

He understands the substantial business and litigation risks associated with these cases and the importance of employing a focused, multidisciplinary approach to their resolution that brings together legal, financial, marketing, public and government relations and risk communications management.

His experience in evaluating and resolving mass claims in multiple jurisdictions is based in large part on his daily, ongoing activities in the following areas:

- Recommending and establishing pre-trial and trial structures designed to resolve contested issues, manage costs and position claims favorably for ultimate resolution
- Compiling an archive of detailed research, intensive motions practice and assessments concerning each state's laws on product liability and the availability and calculation of compensatory, special and punitive damages for product liability claims
